

# VERIFIED COMPLAINT UNDER THE CITIZENS CLEAN ELECTIONS ACT

Dear Director Collins:

I am a qualified Arizona voter. I submit this complaint under A.R.S. § 16-957 and A.A.C. R2-20-809 against **Arizona Senate Victory Fund PAC** ("ASVF"), a political action committee registered with the Arizona Secretary of State (Committee ID 101359), for four discrete violations of A.R.S. § 16-958(B)(3) during the fourteen-day pre-general window of the November 5, 2024 General Election.

The facts are documentary. During the fourteen days before the November 5, 2024 General Election (October 22, 2024 through November 4, 2024), ASVF made independent expenditures totaling **\$674,481.97** across four separate dates, every dollar of which targeted Arizona state legislative races. The breakdown — taken directly from Schedule E2a of ASVF's 2024 Post-General Election (Q4) Report (Exhibit C) — is:

**Every dollar of that activity was either disclosed weeks-to-months past the one-business-day statutory deadline, never disclosed in any daily trigger at all, or covered by a facially-false zero-entry trigger filing.** Specifically:

- The October 22, 2024 IEs (\$89,547.37) were disclosed in a CCEC General Daily Trigger filed November 2, 2024 — **ten days after the one-business-day deadline of October 23, 2024** (Exhibit D).
- The October 23, 2024 IEs (\$15,000.00) were not disclosed in any contemporaneous daily-trigger filing. ASVF instead filed an **empty** CCEC General Daily Trigger on October 24, 2024 covering reporting period October 23, 2024 (Exhibit E), containing zero Schedule E2a entries despite ASVF having made four independent expenditures totaling \$15,000 on that very day. The four IEs first appeared on the Commission's record in the Q4 Post-General filing on **January 15, 2025 — eighty-three days after the one-business-day deadline of October 24, 2024.**
- The October 25, 2024 IEs (\$269,116.70) — thirty-two separate independent expenditures targeting Arizona state senate candidates — were **never disclosed in any CCEC daily trigger.** ASVF filed no daily trigger for the reporting period October 25, 2024. Those thirty-two IEs first appeared on the Commission's record in the Q4 Post-General filing on **January 15, 2025 — seventy-nine days after the one-business-day deadline of October 28, 2024.**
- The October 28, 2024 IEs (\$300,817.90) — the largest single-day IE total of ASVF's 2024 cycle — were disclosed in a CCEC General Daily Trigger filed **January 6, 2025 — sixty-nine days after the one-business-day deadline of October 29, 2024** (Exhibit H).

During the same fourteen-day window, ASVF filed **three additional CCEC General Daily Triggers covering single days on which it had no IE activity at all** (10/24/2024, 10/26/2024, 10/29/2024) — each with zero Schedule E2a entries (Exhibits F, G, I). The pattern of empty triggers covering days with no activity, while the days with material IE activity (10/22, 10/23, 10/25, 10/28) had either no daily-trigger filing at all, an empty filing inconsistent with the underlying record, or a filing weeks-to-months past the statutory deadline, supports a finding of willful non-compliance.

This complaint identifies **four discrete violations** of A.R.S. § 16-958(B)(3), one for each IE date. The aggregate amount of late or never-timely-disclosed campaign-media spending inside the fourteen-day window is **\$674,481.97** — every dollar of ASVF's IE activity during the closing two weeks of the 2024 General Election.

## **I. Compliance with R2-20-809(C)**

This complaint satisfies each requirement of A.A.C. R2-20-809(C):

- 1. R2-20-809(C)(1):** This complaint recites facts describing four discrete violations of A.R.S. § 16-958(B)(3) — ASVF's failure to file timely supplemental independent-expenditure reports for IE activity on October 22, October 23, October 25, and October 28, 2024, each within the fourteen-day pre-general window of the November 5, 2024 General Election. The factual basis is set forth in Sections II and III below.
  - 2. R2-20-809(C)(2):** This complaint identifies Arizona Senate Victory Fund PAC, Arizona Secretary of State Committee ID 101359, as the entity alleged to have committed the violations described herein.
  - 3. R2-20-809(C)(3):** This complaint includes supporting documentation in the form of exhibits referenced throughout and listed in Section VIII.
  - 4. R2-20-809(C)(4):** This complaint differentiates allegations based on personal knowledge from allegations based on information and belief. Each factual allegation in Section II is explicitly labeled as to its evidentiary basis. All factual allegations rest on personal knowledge from direct review of public records.
  - 5.** The contents of this complaint are sworn and will be notarized before filing, as set forth in the Verification page attached hereto.

## II. Factual Background

### A. The Respondent

**1. Based on personal knowledge and direct review of public records:** Arizona Senate Victory Fund PAC is a political action committee registered with the Arizona Secretary of State under Committee ID 101359. ASVF's contact information of record is: Treasurer Ashley Ragan, 2211 East Highland Avenue, Suite 210, Phoenix, AZ 85016, telephone (602) 451-4292, email ashleymragan@cox.net.

**2. Based on personal knowledge and direct review of public records:** ASVF is a substantial outside-spending PAC. Its 2024 cycle Schedule E2a aggregate equals **\$1,987,542.13** in independent expenditures across the cycle (Exhibit C, page 2 "Total to Date" cell of the Summary of Activity for the Independent & Ballot Measure Expenditures row), every dollar of which targeted Arizona state legislative races.

### B. The Statutory Framework

**3.** A.R.S. § 16-941(D) establishes a \$500 cumulative independent-expenditure threshold per office in an election cycle, above which a person making independent expenditures must file an original report under A.R.S. § 16-958. (Section 16-941(D) carves out expenditures described in § 16-920 and intra-organization member/employee/shareholder communications; neither carve-out applies to the IE expenditures at issue here, which are mailings, signs, postage, advertising, and digital and printed campaign communications paid to commercial vendors and reported on Schedule E2a of ASVF's own filings.)

**4.** A.R.S. § 16-958(A) requires that, after the original-report threshold has been crossed, the person "shall file a supplemental report each time previously unreported independent expenditures specified by that subsection exceeds one thousand dollars."

**5. A.R.S. § 16-958(B)(3) establishes the timing for those supplemental reports during the fourteen-day pre-election window:**

*"During the last two weeks before the primary election and the last two weeks before the general election, the person shall file a report within one business day of reaching the dollar amount for filing an original or supplemental report."*

6. The 2024 General Election was held on Tuesday, November 5, 2024. The fourteen-day window of A.R.S. § 16-958(B)(3) therefore ran from **Tuesday, October 22, 2024 through Monday, November 4, 2024**. Within that window, ASVF was obligated to file a CCEC General Daily Trigger report within one business day of any date on which previously unreported independent expenditures exceeded \$1,000.

**C. The Triggering Independent Expenditures**

**7. Based on personal knowledge and direct review of Schedule E2a of ASVF's 2024 Post-General Election (Q4) Report (Exhibit C):** ASVF made independent expenditures inside the fourteen-day daily-trigger window on the following four dates. Each date carried activity dramatically above the \$1,000 supplemental threshold of A.R.S. § 16-958(A) — exceeding it by between approximately fifteen-fold (10/23) and three-hundred-fold (10/28) — and therefore triggered an independent one-business-day filing deadline under A.R.S. § 16-958(B)(3).

**8. Based on personal knowledge:** Schedule E2a of the Q4 Report (Exhibit C, pages 8–17) itemizes each of the seventy-six transactions individually. The totals above are taken from a direct line-by-line read of Exhibit C and reconcile exactly to the "Net Total of Independent Expenditures" cell of \$674,481.97 printed at the bottom of Schedule E2a (Exhibit C, page 17).

## D. The Reports Filed Inside the Daily-Trigger Window

**9. Based on personal knowledge and direct review of public records (Exhibit B, sequential metadata for all 29 ASVF filings; Exhibits D through I for each daily trigger PDF):** Inside the fourteen-day window of October 22 through November 4, 2024, ASVF filed exactly six CCEC General Daily Triggers with the Secretary of State:

**10. No CCEC General Daily Trigger was filed for the reporting period October 25, 2024** — the date of \$269,116.70 in independent-expenditure activity (32 IEs).

**11. The empty Daily Trigger filed on October 24, 2024 covering reporting period October 23, 2024 (Report ID 297719, Exhibit E) is on its face inconsistent with ASVF's own Schedule E2a record.** Schedule E2a of the Q4 Report shows ASVF made four independent expenditures totaling \$15,000 on October 23, 2024 (each \$3,750, paid to Roosevelt Strategies Group, targeting Vote Bolick, Werner For AZ, Judy for AZ, and Chris4Arizona). Those four IEs do not appear on Exhibit E. The October 23, 2024 daily trigger was

submitted as a CCEC General Daily Trigger asserting that no IE activity occurred on October 23, 2024 — when in fact \$15,000 in IEs across four candidates had occurred.

**12. The empty Daily Triggers filed for October 24, 2024 (Exhibit F), October 26, 2024 (Exhibit G), and October 29, 2024 (Exhibit I) cover three single days on which ASVF undertook no independent-expenditure activity at all** per the Q4 Schedule E2a. Each is a zero-entry filing for a no-activity reporting period.

**E. The Late Aggregation in the Q4 Post-General**

**13. Based on personal knowledge and direct review of ASVF's 2024 Post-General Election (Q4) Report (Report ID 296584, Exhibit C):** The Q4 report covers the reporting period October 20, 2024 through December 31, 2024 and was filed on **January 15, 2025**. Schedule E2a of the Q4 Report comprehensively itemizes each of the seventy-six IEs at issue across the four dates of activity inside the fourteen-day daily-trigger window.

**14. Based on personal knowledge and direct calculation:** For the two dates where ASVF eventually filed a CCEC General Daily Trigger (10/22 and 10/28), the trigger filings contain the same IE entries that appear in the Q4 Schedule E2a for those dates. The 11/2/2024 filing (DT 298318) for 10/22 IEs disclosed all eight 10/22 entries totaling \$89,547.37 — but ten days late. The 1/6/2025 filing (DT 298661) for 10/28 IEs disclosed all thirty-two 10/28 entries totaling \$300,817.90 — but sixty-nine days late. **For the two dates where ASVF filed no daily trigger or filed an empty daily trigger (10/23 and 10/25), the Q4 Post-General filing on January 15, 2025 was the first filing on the Commission's record to disclose the IE activity that occurred on those dates.**

**15. The summary of timing for each IE date is:**

**16.** The Post-General (Q4) filing is not a substitute for the daily-trigger reports required by A.R.S. § 16-958(B)(3). The two filings serve different statutory purposes. The fourteen-day daily-trigger reports are designed for **contemporaneous disclosure during the closing window of an election** so that voters, opposing candidates, and the Commission have visibility into outside-spending activity before ballots are cast. A retroactive aggregation 71 to 83 days after the polls have closed cannot satisfy that statutory purpose. The deadline structure on the face of the statute — "within one business day" — cannot be cured by post-election quarterly disclosure.

#### **F. The Empty-Trigger Pattern**

**17. Based on personal knowledge:** Across the eight sequential Tuesday Triggers ASVF filed during the eight-week pre-general window (covering August 27 through October 21, 2024), every Tuesday Trigger contained Schedule E2a entries reflecting actual IE activity in the period covered. ASVF demonstrably understands how a CCEC IE-trigger filing functions when it contains substantive IE activity.

**18.** The four empty CCEC General Daily Trigger reports filed inside the fourteen-day window (Exhibits E, F, G, I) — one of which (10/23, Exhibit E) was filed empty on a day when four IEs in fact occurred — are the only zero-entry IE-trigger filings in ASVF's 2024 cycle.

**19.** The structure of those four empty filings — selecting four single-day reporting periods, three on days with no IE activity (10/24, 10/26, 10/29) and one on a day where IE activity in fact occurred (10/23) — combined with ASVF's failure to file any daily trigger at all for the largest IE day inside the window for which a deadline ran (10/25, \$269,116.70) and the seventy-day late filing for the largest single-day IE total (10/28, \$300,817.90) — supports a finding of willful non-compliance rather than inadvertent administrative error.

---

### **III. Violations of the Citizens Clean Elections Act**

**Violation 1 — No Daily Trigger Filed for the October 25, 2024 IEs (\$269,116.70)**

**20.** ASVF made thirty-two independent expenditures on Friday, October 25, 2024, totaling \$269,116.70 (Exhibit C, Schedule E2a entries dated 10/25/2024, pages 9–13).

**21.** The cumulative previously-unreported expenditures on October 25 — including any amounts unreported from prior dates inside the window — exceeded the \$1,000 supplemental threshold of A.R.S. § 16-958(A) by approximately two-hundred-sixty-nine-fold on this single date.

**22.** Under A.R.S. § 16-958(B)(3), the supplemental report disclosing those expenditures was due **within one business day** — i.e., **Monday, October 28, 2024**.

**23.** **No CCEC General Daily Trigger was filed for the reporting period October 25, 2024** (Exhibit B, sequential filing metadata; the absence of a 10/25 trigger is dispositive on its face).

**24.** The thirty-two IEs of October 25, 2024 first appeared on the Commission's record in the Q4 Post-General filing on **January 15, 2025** — **seventy-nine days after the October 28, 2024 deadline**.

**25.** The failure to file a supplemental report by October 28, 2024 disclosing the thirty-two October 25 IEs totaling \$269,116.70 is a violation of A.R.S. § 16-958(B)(3). This violation is the cleanest of the four on the public record: there is no daily-trigger filing of any kind for this date, populated or empty, and the omission first cured itself only retroactively in the post-election quarterly seventy-nine days later.

**Violation 2 — Late Daily-Trigger Filing for the October 28, 2024 IEs (\$300,817.90)**

**26.** ASVF made thirty-two independent expenditures on Monday, October 28, 2024, totaling \$300,817.90 (Exhibit C, Schedule E2a entries dated 10/28/2024, pages 13–17).

**27.** The cumulative previously-unreported expenditures on October 28 — including the unreported \$15,000 from 10/23 and the unreported \$269,116.70 from 10/25 — exceeded the \$1,000 supplemental threshold of A.R.S. § 16-958(A) by approximately three-hundred-fold on this single date.

**28.** Under A.R.S. § 16-958(B)(3), the supplemental report disclosing those expenditures was due **within one business day** — i.e., **Tuesday, October 29, 2024**.

**29.** ASVF filed a CCEC General Daily Trigger covering reporting period October 28, 2024 (Report ID 298661) on **Monday, January 6, 2025** — **sixty-nine days after the deadline** (Exhibit H).

**30.** The DT 298661 filing fully discloses all thirty-two 10/28 IEs totaling \$300,817.90 — the same entries that appear on Schedule E2a of the Q4 Post-General Report. The violation is one of timing, not coverage: a complete daily trigger filed sixty-nine days outside the one-business-day window.

**31.** The failure to file a supplemental report by October 29, 2024 disclosing the thirty-two October 28 IEs is a violation of A.R.S. § 16-958(B)(3). Given the magnitude of the disbursement (\$300,817.90 — the largest single-day IE total of ASVF's 2024 cycle), the existence of an empty contemporaneous filing on the very same one-business-day deadline date (October 29, 2024 daily trigger filed empty for reporting period 10/29 on November 1, 2024 — Exhibit I), and the sixty-nine-day delay before disclosure, this violation is the most material of the four in dollar magnitude.

### **Violation 3 — Late Daily-Trigger Filing for the October 22, 2024 IEs (\$89,547.37)**

**32.** ASVF made eight independent expenditures on Tuesday, October 22, 2024, totaling \$89,547.37 (Exhibit C, Schedule E2a entries dated 10/22/2024, page 8).

**33.** The cumulative previously-unreported expenditures on October 22 (\$89,547.37) exceeded the \$1,000 supplemental threshold of A.R.S. § 16-958(A) by approximately ninety-fold.

**34.** Under A.R.S. § 16-958(B)(3), the supplemental report disclosing those expenditures was due **within one business day** — i.e., **Wednesday, October 23, 2024**.

**35.** ASVF filed a CCEC General Daily Trigger covering reporting period October 22, 2024 (Report ID 298318) on **Saturday, November 2, 2024** — **ten days after the deadline** (Exhibit D).

**36.** The DT 298318 filing fully discloses all eight 10/22 IEs totaling \$89,547.37 — the same entries that appear on Schedule E2a of the Q4 Post-General Report. The violation is one of timing, not coverage: a complete daily trigger filed ten days outside the one-business-day window.

**37.** The failure to file a supplemental report by October 23, 2024 — and the eventual ten-day late filing on November 2, 2024 — is a violation of A.R.S. § 16-958(B)(3).

**Violation 4 — Facially-False Empty Daily Trigger and Never-Timely-Disclosed October 23, 2024 IEs (\$15,000.00)**

**38.** ASVF made four independent expenditures on Wednesday, October 23, 2024, totaling \$15,000.00 (each \$3,750, paid to Roosevelt Strategies Group, targeting committees 101423 Vote Bolick, 101500 Werner For AZ, 100035 Judy for AZ, and 201800199 Chris4Arizona) (Exhibit C, Schedule E2a entries dated 10/23/2024, page 9).

**39.** The cumulative previously-unreported expenditures on October 23 — including the unreported \$89,547.37 from 10/22 — exceeded the \$1,000 supplemental threshold of A.R.S. § 16-958(A) by approximately one-hundred-fold.

**40.** Under A.R.S. § 16-958(B)(3), the supplemental report disclosing those expenditures was due **within one business day** — i.e., **Thursday, October 24, 2024**.

**41.** ASVF filed a CCEC General Daily Trigger covering reporting period October 23, 2024 (Report ID 297719) on **October 24, 2024** — but the report **contains zero Schedule E2a entries** (Exhibit E). The filing was submitted as a CCEC General Daily Trigger asserting no IE activity occurred on October 23, 2024, when in fact four IEs totaling \$15,000 had occurred.

**42.** The four 10/23 IEs first appeared on the Commission's record in the Q4 Post-General filing on **January 15, 2025** — **eighty-three days after the October 24, 2024 deadline**.

**43.** The failure to file a non-empty supplemental report by October 24, 2024 disclosing the four October 23 IEs — combined with the facially-false zero-entry filing of Report 297719 — is a violation of A.R.S. § 16-958(B)(3). The simultaneous existence of an "on-time" empty filing covering the very date of unreported IE activity is independently probative of intent.

---

## IV. Penalty Considerations

**44.** The civil penalty for an independent-expenditure reporting violation is determined under A.R.S. § 16-957 and the Commission's enforcement rules, with severity tied to the duration of the violation, the magnitude of the undisclosed activity, and the existence of any pattern of similar conduct.

**45.** For these four violations, four factors should be weighed at the maximum end of any applicable range:

**a. Magnitude:** The total late-or-never-timely-disclosed amount during the fourteen-day window is **\$674,481.97** — every dollar of ASVF's IE activity during the closing two weeks of the 2024 General Election. The two dates with no daily-trigger filing or with a falsely-empty filing (10/23 and 10/25) account for \$284,116.70 of that figure.

**b. Duration:** The latest disclosure was 83 days past the deadline (10/23 IEs); the earliest was 10 days (10/22 IEs). Three of the four violations remained undisclosed for at least 69 days and fell entirely outside the fourteen-day pre-election window the statute is designed to protect.

**c. False-attestation pattern:** ASVF filed a facially-false empty CCEC General Daily Trigger covering October 23, 2024 (Report 297719) on a day when four IEs totaling \$15,000 had in fact occurred — submitting a sworn statement that no IE activity had taken place on a date when ASVF's own Q4 Schedule E2a records four IEs. ASVF also filed three additional empty CCEC General Daily Triggers covering single days on which it had no IE activity at all (10/24, 10/26, 10/29). The combined pattern — four empty filings in a fourteen-day window, three for genuinely no-activity days and one for a day where activity in fact occurred — supports a finding of willful non-compliance rather than inadvertent administrative error.

**d. Sophistication of the filer:** ASVF also filed VRKA Supplemental Reports under A.R.S. § 16-973(B) on October 25 and October 29, 2024, demonstrating that the committee both understood and was capable of meeting contemporaneous-disclosure obligations under separate statutory regimes during the very same window. The CCEC § 16-958(B)(3) failures cannot plausibly be attributed to inability to file timely reports.

**46.** To the extent the Commission imposes per-day penalties, the cumulative late-day count across the four violations is **241 days** (10 + 83 + 79 + 69 days).

## V. Statutory Timeline and Demands

I am providing the Commission with the following timeline expectations based on the Commission's own rules:

I request written confirmation of receipt and assignment of a complaint number pursuant to R2-20-809(F) no later than May 14, 2026.

A.R.S. § 16-957(A) requires the Commission, on a finding of reason to believe a violation has occurred, to "serve on the person an order stating with reasonable particularity the nature of the violation and requiring compliance within fourteen days." Section 16-957(B) provides that where the alleged violator does not bring the matter into compliance within those fourteen days, "the commission shall make a public finding to that effect" and "issue an order assessing a civil penalty in accordance with section 16-942."

## VI. Note on Dismissal Authority

A.A.C. R2-20-206(A)(3) permits the Executive Director to close a complaint at the staff level upon "the respondent complying with the statute or rule on which the complaint is founded." By the rule's own

terms, staff closure is conditioned on respondent compliance — not on a discretionary determination that the complaint is not worth pursuing.

**That conditional cannot be satisfied here.** The statute on which this complaint is founded — A.R.S. § 16-958(B)(3) — required ASVF to file each supplemental report "within one business day" of an October 22, October 23, October 25, or October 28, 2024 IE. Those one-business-day deadlines are gone. There is no compliance available now: ASVF cannot retroactively meet a deadline that ran in October 2024, and the Q4 Post-General disclosure on January 15, 2025 does not cure a § 16-958(B)(3) timing violation. Because the predicate compliance act under R2-20-206(A)(3) is impossible to perform, the staff-closure path R2-20-206(A)(3) authorizes is not available on these facts.

This complaint rests entirely on documentary evidence pulled from the Commission's own public-record system. ASVF's own Schedule E2a in ASVF's own Q4 Post-General report shows the four IE dates, the seventy-six itemized transactions, and the \$674,481.97 in 14-day-window activity. ASVF's own four empty Daily Triggers — three for days with no activity and one (10/23) for a day where four IEs in fact occurred — are blank on their face. ASVF's own filing metadata at SeeTheMoney shows no Daily Trigger at all for October 25, 2024. ASVF's own late Daily Trigger for October 22, 2024 is dated November 2, 2024 — ten days after the statutory deadline. ASVF's own late Daily Trigger for October 28, 2024 is dated January 6, 2025 — sixty-nine days after the statutory deadline. There is no factual question to investigate. The Commission can verify every paragraph of this complaint by clicking through to the corresponding [seethemoney.az.gov](https://seethemoney.az.gov) record.

Given (a) the magnitude of the late-or-never-timely-disclosed activity (the entire **\$674,481.97** of ASVF's IE activity inside the fourteen-day window, with the largest single-day IE total of the cycle disclosed sixty-nine days late and the second-largest never disclosed in any daily trigger), (b) the duration of the violations (10 to 83 days), and (c) the empty-trigger pattern that includes a facially-false zero-entry filing on a day when activity in fact occurred, this complaint is appropriate for **referral to the full Commission** rather than staff-level closure.

---

## VII. Requested Action

I respectfully request that the Commission:

**1. Investigate** ASVF's failure to file timely supplemental independent-expenditure reports under A.R.S. § 16-958(B)(3) for the October 22, October 23, October 25, and October 28, 2024 IEs;

**2. Determine** that the four empty CCEC General Daily Trigger filings — Report IDs 297719 (10/23), 297831 (10/24), 297883 (10/26), and 298235 (10/29) — do not satisfy the disclosure obligation of A.R.S. § 16-958(B)(3), and that the October 23, 2024 zero-entry filing (Exhibit E) is on its face inconsistent with ASVF's own Schedule E2a record of four IEs totaling \$15,000 on that date;

**3. Determine** that the late aggregation of the October 23 and October 25 IEs into the Q4 Post-General report filed January 15, 2025 does not cure the cadence violations on the face of A.R.S. § 16-958(B)(3);

**4. Issue an order under A.R.S. § 16-957(A)** requiring ASVF to comply with A.R.S. § 16-958 and stating the nature of the four violations;

**5. Assess civil penalties** under A.R.S. § 16-957(B) and § 16-942 calibrated to the magnitude of the late-or-never-timely-disclosed activity (\$674,481.97), the duration of the violations (10 to 83 days), and the empty-trigger and false-attestation patterns documented in Section II.F;

**6. Refer this complaint to the full Commission for a vote** — do not dismiss at the staff level under R2-20-206(A)(3) for the reasons set forth in Section VI;

**7. Provide written confirmation** of receipt and a complaint number pursuant to R2-20-809(F).
