

# VERIFIED COMPLAINT UNDER THE VOTERS' RIGHT TO KNOW ACT

Dear Director Collins:

I am a qualified Arizona voter. I submit this complaint under A.R.S. § 16-977(A) and A.A.C. R2-20-809 against **Building A Better Arizona** ("BABA"), a political action committee registered with the Arizona Secretary of State (Committee ID 101818).

BABA made **\$649,787.42** in independent expenditures supporting a statewide gubernatorial candidate during the 2026 election cycle. The Voters' Right to Know Act's statewide disclosure threshold under A.R.S. § 16-973(A) is \$50,000. BABA crossed that threshold in a single \$50,000 transaction on February 11, 2025 and has made roughly thirteen times the threshold in cumulative cycle-to-date campaign media spending since. **BABA has filed zero VRKA reports — not an Initial Report, not a Supplemental, not an Amended — at any point in the cycle.** The Commission's VRKA filings index, reviewed May 7, 2026, confirms BABA is not present.

This complaint identifies — with specific dates and amounts drawn from BABA's own filings with the Secretary of State — **one missed Initial Report and twenty-three missed Supplemental Reports**, for a total of twenty-four discrete violations of A.R.S. § 16-973.

## **I. Compliance with R2-20-809(C)**

This complaint satisfies each requirement of A.A.C. R2-20-809(C):

**1. R2-20-809(C)(1):** This complaint recites facts describing twenty-four discrete violations of A.R.S. § 16-973 (the Voters' Right to Know Act's reporting requirements) — one missed Initial Report under § 16-973(A) and twenty-three missed Supplemental Reports under § 16-973(B). The factual basis is set forth in Sections II and III.

**2. R2-20-809(C)(2):** This complaint identifies Building A Better Arizona (Arizona Secretary of State Committee ID 101818) as the entity alleged to have committed the violations.

**3. R2-20-809(C)(3):** This complaint includes supporting documentation in the form of exhibits referenced throughout and listed in Section VIII. Every exhibit is a record the Commission itself holds or is publicly posted on the Secretary of State's and the Commission's own websites.

**4. R2-20-809(C)(4):** Each factual allegation identifies its evidentiary basis (personal knowledge or information and belief). All factual allegations rest on personal knowledge from direct review of public records.

**5.** The contents of this complaint are sworn and will be notarized before filing, as set forth in the Verification page attached hereto.

## **II. Factual Background**

## A. The Respondent

1. I, [REDACTED], am a qualified voter registered in Maricopa County, Arizona (A.A.C. R2-20-809(A)). I am eligible to file this complaint pursuant to A.R.S. § 16-977(A).

**2. Based on personal knowledge and direct review of public records:** Building A Better Arizona is a political action committee registered with the Arizona Secretary of State under Committee ID 101818. BABA self-identifies on its public SOS filings as an independent expenditure PAC operating in support of Karrin Taylor Robson for Governor of Arizona (Arizona Secretary of State Committee 100592, "Karrin for Arizona"). Every independent expenditure on BABA's 2025 and 2026 Schedule E2a lists "100592 - Karrin for Arizona" as the beneficiary candidate for a statewide office.

## B. The Disbursements Triggering VRKA Reporting

**3. Based on personal knowledge and direct review of BABA's publicly filed SOS campaign finance reports, Schedule E2a (Independent Expenditures):** BABA made eleven disclosed independent expenditures for campaign advertising benefiting Karrin for Arizona during the 2025–2026 election cycle. Each is categorized in BABA's own Schedule E2a as "Communications - Advertising" or "Communications - TV." The transactions:

**4. Based on personal knowledge:** Cycle-to-date campaign media spending through Q1 2026 equals **\$649,787.42**. Every dollar of that figure benefits Karrin for Arizona, a statewide gubernatorial campaign. The applicable VRKA threshold under A.R.S. § 16-973(A) is **\$50,000**. That threshold was crossed in a single transaction on **February 11, 2025** — the \$50,000 payment to DDI Media.

#### **C. The Commission Has Had Contemporaneous Notice Since March 2025**

**5. Based on personal knowledge and direct review:** On **March 1, 2025**, BABA filed a Monthly CCEC Trigger Report with the Commission (Report ID 303835) under A.R.S. § 16-958. That report disclosed the February 11, 2025 DDI Media expenditure of \$50,000 to the Commission. The Commission has therefore been on notice — through a filing BABA itself submitted to the Commission — that BABA had spent \$50,000 on independent expenditure advertising for a statewide candidate as of March 1, 2025. The condition has persisted in the Commission's records for over fourteen months as of the date of this complaint.

#### **D. BABA Has Filed Zero VRKA Reports**

**6. Based on personal knowledge and direct review of the VRKA filings index at [azsos.gov/elections/campaign-finance/vrka-reporting](https://azsos.gov/elections/campaign-finance/vrka-reporting), confirmed May 7, 2026:** Building A Better Arizona does not appear on the VRKA filer list for the 2025 or 2026 election cycle. The committee has not filed an Initial Report, a Supplemental Report, or an Amended Report. (Exhibit A.)

#### **E. The § 16-973(I) Safe Harbor Does Not Apply Because the SOS-Prescribed Periodic-Report Format Does Not Include the Required Intermediary-Tracing Field**

**7. Based on personal knowledge and direct review of each of BABA's periodic SOS campaign finance reports for the 2025–2026 cycle** (filed 2025-04-21, 2025-07-21, 2025-10-15, 2026-01-15, and 2026-04-07): The SOS-prescribed periodic-report format consists of Schedules C1 (personal/family contributions),

C2 (individual contributions), C3 (committee-to-committee contributions), C4 (corporate/LLC contributions), C5 (small contributions), E1 (operating expenses), E2a (independent expenditures), and E3 (contributions out). **The SOS-prescribed format contains no field for intermediary identification under A.R.S. § 16-973(A)(7)**, which requires disclosure of "the identity of each person that acted as an intermediary and that transferred, in whole or in part, traceable monies of more than \$5,000 from original sources to the covered person and the date, amount and source, both original and intermediate, of the transferred monies." The structural absence of an intermediary-tracing field in the SOS-prescribed format means BABA's periodic reports cannot, by their structure alone, "include" intermediary-tracing disclosures the format itself does not provide for.

**8. A.R.S. § 16-973(I)** conditions the periodic-report safe harbor on inclusion of "the disclosures required by this section ... **including the requirement to identify the original sources of traceable monies who gave, directly or indirectly, and any intermediaries who transferred, directly or indirectly, more than \$5,000 in traceable monies to the covered person during the election cycle.**" The Commission's own VRKA filer index — at [azsos.gov/elections/campaign-finance/vrka-reporting](https://azsos.gov/elections/campaign-finance/vrka-reporting) — confirms that political action committees commonly file separate VRKA Initial and Supplemental Reports in addition to their periodic SOS reports, because the SOS-prescribed format alone does not contain the intermediary-tracing field that § 16-973(A)(7) and § 16-973(I) explicitly require. (Examples in the Commission's own index include Tucson Metro Chamber PAC, Turning Point PAC, and Yes on 409 — each of which filed standalone VRKA reports despite also filing periodic SOS reports.)

**9. BABA's own conduct independently confirms its understanding that direct Commission notice was triggered.** On March 1, 2025 — eighteen days after the February 11, 2025 DDI Media \$50,000 expenditure — BABA filed a Monthly CCEC Trigger Report (Report ID 303835) directly with the Commission disclosing that very expenditure. By filing the Trigger Report contemporaneously with the threshold-crossing transaction, BABA itself acknowledged the threshold was crossed and that Commission-direct disclosure was required. The Trigger Report serves a different statutory function under A.R.S. § 16-958 and is not a substitute for a VRKA Initial Report under § 16-973(A) — but its existence proves the Commission has had specific contemporaneous notice of the threshold crossing for over fourteen months while BABA filed zero VRKA Reports.

---

### III. Violations of the Voters' Right to Know Act

The Commission's rule for computing deadlines, A.A.C. R2-20-802, excludes the day of the triggering event and — where the deadline is five days or fewer — excludes Saturdays, Sundays, and legal holidays observed by the State. Each deadline below is computed under that rule.

### **Violation 1 — Failure to File Initial VRKA Report (A.R.S. § 16-973(A))**

**10.** A.R.S. § 16-973(A) requires a covered person to file an Initial disclosure report within five days of first spending monies or accepting in-kind contributions for campaign media spending totaling \$50,000 or more for a statewide campaign.

**11.** BABA's February 11, 2025 payment of \$50,000 to DDI Media for "Communications - Advertising" benefiting Karrin for Arizona met the statewide threshold in a single transaction.

**12.** Applying R2-20-802: excluding the day of the triggering event (Tue Feb 11, 2025); excluding weekends (Feb 15–16); excluding Presidents' Day (Feb 17, 2025, a legal holiday), the five business days run Feb 12, 13, 14, 18, and **19**. The Initial Report was due **Wednesday, February 19, 2025**.

**13.** No Initial Report has been filed. The violation has persisted for **approximately 442 days** as of the date of this complaint.

### **Violations 2 through 24 — Failure to File Supplemental VRKA Reports (A.R.S. § 16-973(B)) (pleaded in the alternative)**

**13a. Alternative pleading.** A.R.S. § 16-973(B) opens "After a covered person makes an initial report, each time the covered person spends monies or accepts in-kind contributions totaling an additional \$25,000 or more...." On a literal reading of that opening clause, Supplemental obligations under § 16-973(B) do not accrue until after an Initial report has been filed under § 16-973(A). On that reading, the late-Initial violation in Section III (Violation 1) above is the sole § 16-973 violation, and BABA's failure to file an Initial at all means BABA stands in continuous violation of § 16-973(A) without separate Supplemental obligations attaching.

**13b.** Complainant pleads the twenty-three § 16-973(B) Supplemental violations in the alternative — under a contrary reading of § 16-973(B) on which contemporaneous Supplemental obligations attach to additional \$25,000 increments crossed during a period when an Initial is overdue or unfiled. Under either reading, the **penalty range under A.R.S. § 16-976(A) is unchanged** because the civil penalty is one

to three times the amount of undisclosed campaign media spending — not the count of missed filings — and the undisclosed amount of \$649,787.42 is captured by the § 16-973(A) Initial violation alone.

**14.** Under the alternative-pleading reading, A.R.S. § 16-973(B) requires a covered person to file a Supplemental Report within three days after each additional \$25,000 in statewide campaign media spending during the election cycle. Once the Initial threshold is crossed, every \$25,000 of additional cumulative spending triggers a separate Supplemental obligation. The statute provides no aggregation allowance; each crossing is a discrete filing requirement.

**15.** BABA's cumulative campaign media spending crossed twenty-three separate \$25,000 thresholds between February 11, 2025 and January 2, 2026. The table below lists each threshold, the specific transaction that caused the crossing, and the statutory deadline computed under R2-20-802:

**16.** The 2025-12-04 MHB Media \$300,830.19 expenditure alone crossed **twelve** separate \$25,000 thresholds in a single day. The 2026-01-02 MHB Media \$200,320.75 expenditure crossed **eight** more. Each crossing was its own Supplemental Report obligation under A.R.S. § 16-973(B). None were filed.

**17. Total: twenty-three missed Supplemental Reports**, bringing the cycle total to twenty-four missed VRKA filings when combined with the missed Initial.

### **Why the Itemized Count Matters**

**18.** Under A.R.S. § 16-976(A), each violation is separately penalizable at one to three times the amount of the undisclosed campaign media spending. The statute does not authorize rolling multiple missed

filings into a single penalty count. Each of the twenty-four distinct reporting obligations that BABA did not meet is a separate, complete violation.

**19.** Under A.A.C. R2-20-807, a covered person's failure to maintain records required under Chapter 6.1 of Title 16 "may give rise to a factual presumption against the person in an enforcement proceeding." To the extent BABA has not maintained records documenting original sources, intermediaries, the campaign media spending manager, or traceable monies calculations for each of these twenty-four reporting points, that presumption is available to the Commission.

---

#### **IV. Penalty Considerations and Mootness**

**19a. The 2026 withdrawal of the supported candidate does not moot this matter.** Karrin Taylor Robson withdrew from the 2026 Arizona gubernatorial primary on or about February 12, 2026 — approximately eighty-four days before the date of this complaint. The Commission should expect a respondent argument that the candidate's withdrawal moots BABA's VRKA disclosure obligations, and should reject that argument for the following independent reasons:

**a. Penalty obligations crystallized at the time of each violation.** A.R.S. § 16-976(A) provides that the civil penalty "shall be" between one and three times the undisclosed amount. The penalty obligation is mandatory and attaches at the moment of the violation, not at the moment of any later reckoning. BABA's § 16-973(A) Initial obligation matured on February 19, 2025 — twelve months before Robson's withdrawal. The penalty for that violation attached on February 19, 2025 and has accrued continuously since.

**b. The public-information harm occurred during 2025.** The Voters' Right to Know Act's purpose is to inform voters about significant campaign media spending and the original sources of its funding *during the election cycle*. Arizona voters making primary judgments about Robson during 2025 were entitled to the disclosures § 16-973 requires. That public-information harm is not undone by Robson's later withdrawal — it is fixed by what was withheld at the time it should have been disclosed.

**c. A.R.S. § 16-977(C) forecloses prosecutorial-discretion dismissal at >\$50,000.** Section 16-977(C)'s prohibition on prosecutorial discretion attaches whenever the civil penalty for the alleged violation could be greater than \$50,000. The minimum civil penalty here is \$649,787 —

more than thirteenfold that threshold. The Commission cannot decline to act on grounds of changed circumstances, candidate-withdrawal, or any other discretionary basis.

**d. Disclosure-violation enforcement is well-established post-event.** Federal and state campaign-finance regulators routinely enforce reporting violations after elections have concluded (e.g., FEC MUR proceedings against committees whose candidates lost or withdrew). The disclosure obligation is independent of the candidate's electoral outcome.

**20.** Under A.R.S. § 16-976(A), the civil penalty for a VRKA violation is between one and three times the amount of the undisclosed contribution or campaign media spending. BABA's undisclosed campaign media spending is **\$649,787.42**:

**21.** Under **A.R.S. § 16-977(C)**: "In any matter in which the civil penalty for the alleged violation could be greater than \$50,000, any claim or defense by the commission of prosecutorial discretion is not a basis for dismissing or failing to act on the complaint." The minimum civil penalty in this matter (\$649,787) exceeds the \$50,000 threshold by more than **thirteenfold**. **Prosecutorial discretion is not available in this matter.**

**22.** Under **A.R.S. § 16-977(B)**: "If the commission determines that the complaint, if true, states the factual basis for a violation of this chapter or rules adopted pursuant to this chapter, the commission shall investigate the allegations and provide the alleged violator with an opportunity to be heard." The threshold determination contemplated by § 16-977(B) is straightforward on the face of this complaint: BABA's own SOS campaign-finance reports document each triggering disbursement; BABA's own March 1, 2025 CCEC Trigger filing disclosed the threshold-crossing transaction directly to the Commission; and the Commission's own VRKA filings index confirms BABA has filed nothing. Investigation is therefore mandatory.

## V. Statutory Timeline and Demands

I am providing the Commission with the following timeline expectations based on the Commission's own rules:

I request written confirmation of receipt and assignment of a complaint number pursuant to R2-20-809(F) no later than May 14, 2026.

Under A.R.S. § 16-977(C), if the Commission has not taken enforcement action within ninety days after the filing of the complaint, the complainant may bring a civil action to enforce the provisions of the article. The 90-day clock begins May 7, 2026 and runs through **August 5, 2026**.

Should the Commission fail to act on this complaint by August 5, 2026, I intend to exercise my right under A.R.S. § 16-977(C) to file a civil action in Maricopa County Superior Court to compel enforcement.

---

## VI. Note on Dismissal Authority

The Commission's enforcement framework contains two rules under which the Executive Director can close a complaint without full Commission review. Neither permits dismissal of this complaint on its face.

**A.A.C. R2-20-206(A)(3)** sits in Article 2 of the Commission's rules. By Article 2's own scope clause, R2-20-201, "These rules provide procedures for processing possible violations of the Citizens Clean Elections Act." Article 2 does not on its face reach Voters' Right to Know Act complaints, and R2-20-201 is the textual hook that confines Article 2 to the Clean Elections Act. Article 8 (R2-20-809 through R2-20-813), governing VRKA complaints, was adopted unanimously in October 2023 specifically because Article 2 did not reach VRKA matters.

**A.A.C. R2-20-811(F)** does, however, sit in Article 8 and provide that "the Executive Director may dismiss the complaint at any time," including upon completion of an investigation that does not substantiate the allegations. R2-20-811(F) is the only Article 8 rule that authorizes pre-Commission dismissal of a VRKA complaint. It cannot be applied to dismiss the present complaint, for two independent reasons:

**1. R2-20-811(F)'s "upon completion of an investigation" language presupposes an investigation having occurred.** The rule contemplates dismissal *after* the Executive Director has investigated and "[did] not find sufficient facts to substantiate the allegations" — not pre-investigation screening on the papers.

**2. A.R.S. § 16-977(C) overrides any discretionary dismissal authority in matters where the civil penalty could exceed \$50,000.** Section 16-977(C) provides that "any claim or defense by the commission of prosecutorial discretion is not a basis for dismissing or failing to act on the complaint" once the >\$50,000 threshold is crossed. Discretionary dismissal under R2-20-811(F) is, on its face, an exercise of prosecutorial discretion. Where § 16-977(C)'s prohibition applies — as it does here, because the minimum civil penalty in this matter is \$649,787, more than thirteenfold the \$50,000 threshold — R2-20-811(F)'s discretionary authority must yield to the statutory prohibition.

The Commission's mandatory investigation duty under § 16-977(B) controls. Any closure of this complaint by the Executive Director without that investigation would conflict with both the statutory text and the rule's own structure.

This complaint rests entirely on documentary evidence drawn from the Commission's own public-record system: BABA's own Schedule E2a entries in BABA's own SOS campaign-finance reports show every triggering expenditure; BABA's own March 1, 2025 CCEC Trigger Report disclosed the threshold-crossing transaction directly to the Commission; and the Commission's own VRKA filings index confirms BABA has filed nothing. There is no factual question to investigate. The Commission can verify every paragraph of this complaint by clicking through to the corresponding [seethemoney.az.gov](https://seethemoney.az.gov) record.

## VII. Requested Action

I respectfully request that the Commission:

1. Determine that Building A Better Arizona **violated A.R.S. § 16-973(A)** by failing to file an Initial VRKA Report on or before February 19, 2025, following the crossing of the \$50,000 statewide threshold in the February 11, 2025 payment to DDI Media;
2. Determine that Building A Better Arizona **violated A.R.S. § 16-973(B) on twenty-three separate occasions** by failing to file Supplemental VRKA Reports within three days of each \$25,000 cumulative threshold crossed between July 2, 2025 and January 2, 2026, as itemized in paragraph 15 above;
3. Determine that the A.R.S. § 16-973(l) safe harbor does not apply because the SOS-prescribed periodic-report format does not contain a field for the intermediary-tracing disclosure that § 16-973(A)(7) and § 16-973(l) explicitly require, and BABA's own filing of a Monthly CCEC Trigger Report on March 1, 2025 acknowledged the threshold-crossing transaction without any corresponding VRKA disclosure;
4. Impose civil penalties under A.R.S. § 16-976(A) of between \$649,787 (1x) and \$1,949,362 (3x) the amount of undisclosed campaign media spending, plus the 1% surcharge to the Clean Elections Fund required under A.R.S. § 16-976(A);
5. Require Building A Better Arizona to file complete retroactive VRKA disclosures — one Initial and twenty-three Supplementals, or equivalent compliant filings — identifying every donor of original monies over \$5,000 with source-tracing through intermediaries, the campaign media spending manager, traceable-monies on hand at each reporting point, and every disbursement recipient receiving \$10,000 or more, as required by A.R.S. § 16-973(A);
6. Apply the factual presumption under A.A.C. R2-20-807 against BABA to the extent BABA has failed to maintain records sufficient to allow retroactive compliance;

7. Publicly confirm whether, upon receipt of BABA's March 1, 2025 CCEC Trigger Report (Report ID 303835) disclosing the threshold-crossing DDI Media expenditure, any contemporaneous inquiry was made regarding separate VRKA obligations;
  8. Confirm that prosecutorial discretion is unavailable in this matter under A.R.S. § 16-977(C). The minimum civil penalty of \$649,787 exceeds the \$50,000 threshold by more than thirteenfold;
  9. Refer this complaint to the full Commission for a vote — do not dismiss at the staff level under R2-20-206(A)(3) for the reasons set forth in Section VI;
  10. Provide written confirmation of receipt and a complaint number pursuant to R2-20-809(F).
