Dear Director Collins:

I am a qualified Arizona voter. I submit this complaint under A.R.S. § 16-957 and A.A.C. R2-20-809 against **House Victory Fund** ("HVF"), a political action committee registered with the Arizona Secretary of State (Committee ID 101395), for three discrete violations of A.R.S. § 16-958(B)(3) during the fourteen-day pre-general window of the November 5, 2024 General Election.

The violations are simple, documentary, and self-evident on the face of the public record. During the fourteen days before the November 5, 2024 General Election (October 22, 2024 through November 4, 2024), HVF made independent expenditures totaling **\$60,726.45** on three separate dates (October 24, October 28, and October 31, 2024), every dollar of which targeted Arizona state legislative races and opposed Democratic candidates. None of those independent expenditures were disclosed in any contemporaneous filing as A.R.S. § 16-958(B)(3) requires. They appeared on the Commission's records for the first time in HVF's Post-General (Q4) report filed **January 15, 2025 — between 75 and 82 days after each one-business-day deadline.**

During the same fourteen-day window, HVF did file two CCEC General Daily Trigger reports — one for reporting period October 26, 2024 (filed October 29) and one for reporting period October 29, 2024 (filed November 1). **Both filings are facially empty.** Neither contains a single Schedule E2a entry. Each was filed to cover a single day on which HVF undertook no independent-expenditure activity at all, while the actual IE dates (October 24, October 28, and October 31) were skipped. The pattern is documented in the exhibits attached.

This complaint identifies **three discrete violations** of A.R.S. § 16-958(B)(3), one for each missed daily-trigger deadline.

I. Compliance with R2-20-809(C)

This complaint satisfies each requirement of A.A.C. R2-20-809(C):

- 1. R2-20-809(C)(1):** This complaint recites facts describing three discrete violations of A.R.S. § 16-958(B)(3) — HVF's failure to file timely supplemental independent-expenditure reports on October 25, 2024, October 29, 2024, and November 1, 2024, for IEs made on October 24, October 28, and October 31, 2024 respectively. The factual basis is set forth in Sections II and III below.
- 2. R2-20-809(C)(2):** This complaint identifies House Victory Fund, Arizona Secretary of State Committee ID 101395, as the entity alleged to have committed the violations described herein.
- 3. R2-20-809(C)(3):** This complaint includes supporting documentation in the form of exhibits referenced throughout and listed in Section VIII.
- 4. R2-20-809(C)(4):** This complaint differentiates allegations based on personal knowledge from allegations based on information and belief. Each factual allegation in Section II is explicitly labeled as to its evidentiary basis. All factual allegations rest on personal knowledge from direct review of public records.
- 5.** The contents of this complaint are sworn and will be notarized before filing, as set forth in the Verification page attached hereto.

II. Factual Background

A. The Respondent

1. Based on personal knowledge and direct review of public records: House Victory Fund is a political action committee registered with the Arizona Secretary of State under Committee ID 101395. HVF's contact information of record is: Treasurer Ashley Ragan, 2211 East Highland Avenue, Suite 210, Phoenix, AZ 85016, telephone (602) 451-4292, email ashley@incomplianceaz.com.

2. Based on personal knowledge and direct review of public records: HVF is a substantial outside-spending PAC. Its 2024 cycle Schedule E2a aggregate equals **\$1,861,629.24** in independent expenditures across the cycle, all targeting Arizona state legislative races (Exhibit A; cross-reference Exhibit C, page 2 "Total to Date" cell of the Summary of Activity).

B. The Statutory Framework

3. A.R.S. § 16-941(D) establishes a \$500 cumulative independent-expenditure threshold per office in an election cycle, above which a person making independent expenditures must file an original report under A.R.S. § 16-958. (Section 16-941(D) carves out expenditures described in § 16-920 and intra-organization member/employee/shareholder communications; neither carve-out applies to the IE expenditures at issue here, which are public mailings, signs, and digital advertising paid to commercial vendors and reported on Schedule E2a of HVF's own filings.)

4. A.R.S. § 16-958(A) requires that, after the original-report threshold has been crossed, the person "shall file a supplemental report each time previously unreported independent expenditures specified by that subsection exceeds one thousand dollars."

5. A.R.S. § 16-958(B)(3) establishes the timing for those supplemental reports during the fourteen-day pre-election window:

"During the last two weeks before the primary election and the last two weeks before the general election, the person shall file a report within one business day of reaching the dollar amount for filing an original or supplemental report."

6. The 2024 General Election was held on Tuesday, November 5, 2024. The fourteen-day window of A.R.S. § 16-958(B)(3) therefore ran from **Tuesday, October 22, 2024 through Monday, November 4, 2024**. Within that window, HVF was obligated to file a CCEC General Daily Trigger report within one business day of any date on which previously unreported independent expenditures exceeded \$1,000.

C. The Triggering Independent Expenditures

7. **Based on personal knowledge and direct review of HVF's 2024 Post-General Election (Q4) Report — Schedule E2a (Exhibit C):** HVF made the following independent expenditures inside the fourteen-day daily-trigger window of the November 5, 2024 General Election. Each IE date is well above the \$1,000 supplemental-report threshold of A.R.S. § 16-958(A) and triggered an independent one-business-day filing deadline under A.R.S. § 16-958(B)(3).

8. Based on personal knowledge: The 2024-10-28 Awareness Analytics buy alone — twelve separately-itemized independent expenditures totaling \$59,000 — represents the largest single-day disbursement to any IE vendor in HVF's full 2024 cycle Schedule E2a outside of one earlier September 2024 buy that fell inside a Tuesday-trigger period and was timely disclosed.

D. The Reports Filed Inside the Daily-Trigger Window

9. Based on personal knowledge and direct review of public records (Exhibits B, D, E): Inside the fourteen-day window of October 22 through November 4, 2024, HVF filed exactly two reports with the Secretary of State, both labeled "2024 - CCEC General Daily Trigger":

10. Both filings are facially empty. Each report's Schedule E2a contains the column headers "Transaction Date / Benefits or Opposes / Committee ID — Name / Amount" followed by zero data rows. Each is signed and submitted as a CCEC General Daily Trigger asserting that no IE activity occurred on the single day covered by the report.

11. No Daily Trigger report was filed for October 24, 2024.

12. No Daily Trigger report was filed for October 28, 2024 — the date of the \$59,000 Awareness Analytics buy.

13. No Daily Trigger report was filed for October 31, 2024.

E. The Late Aggregation in the Q4 Post-General

14. Based on personal knowledge and direct review of HVF's 2024 Post-General Election (Q4) Report (Report ID 296298): The Q4 report covers the reporting period October 20, 2024 through December 31, 2024 and was filed on January 15, 2025. The three independent expenditures listed in Paragraph 7 above appear on Schedule E2a of that report — specifically on its pages 10, 11, and 12 in the Schedule E2a "Independent Expenditures" section (Exhibit C).

15. Based on personal knowledge: The first time the three IE transactions of October 24, October 28, and October 31, 2024 appeared on the Commission's record of HVF filings was January 15, 2025 — the date of the Post-General (Q4) filing.

16. The interval between each missed filing deadline and the actual disclosure date is:

17. The Post-General (Q4) filing is not a substitute for the daily-trigger reports required by A.R.S. § 16-958(B)(3). The two filings serve different statutory purposes. The fourteen-day daily-trigger reports are designed for **contemporaneous disclosure during the closing window of an election** so that voters, opposing candidates, and the Commission have visibility into outside-spending activity before ballots are cast. A retroactive aggregation 75 to 82 days after the polls have closed cannot satisfy that statutory purpose. The deadline structure on the face of the statute — "**within one business day**" — cannot be cured by post-election quarterly disclosure.

F. The Empty-Trigger Pattern

18. **Based on personal knowledge:** Across the five sequential Tuesday Triggers HVF filed during the eight-week pre-general window (covering September 10 through October 21, 2024), every Tuesday Trigger contained Schedule E2a entries reflecting actual IE activity in the period covered. HVF demonstrably understands how a CCEC IE-trigger filing functions when it contains substantive IE activity.

19. The two CCEC General Daily Trigger reports filed inside the fourteen-day window (Exhibits D and E) — both empty — are the only two filings in HVF's 2024 IE-trigger filing history that bear the IE-trigger form structure with zero data rows. (The Tuesday and Daily Trigger reports filed at all other points in the cycle are populated.)

20. The structure of the two empty filings — selecting two single-day reporting periods (10/26, 10/29) on which HVF had **no** IE activity, while filing **nothing** for the three single-day reporting periods (10/24, 10/28, 10/31) on which HVF **did** have IE activity — supports a finding of willful non-compliance rather than inadvertent administrative error. The Commission may consider that pattern in evaluating the appropriate civil penalty.

III. Violations of the Citizens Clean Elections Act

Violation 1 — Failure to File Daily Trigger for the October 24, 2024 IE (\$1,000.27)

21. HVF made an independent expenditure of \$1,000.27 to Convergent PrintGroup on Thursday, October 24, 2024, opposing Committee 101641 Gonzales For AZ (Communications - Signs) (Exhibit C, Schedule E2a entry).

22. The expenditure exceeded the \$1,000 supplemental threshold of A.R.S. § 16-958(A).

23. Under A.R.S. § 16-958(B)(3), the supplemental report disclosing this expenditure was due **within one business day** — i.e., **Friday, October 25, 2024**.

24. HVF did not file any report on October 24, October 25, or October 28, 2024, that disclosed this IE. No subsequent daily trigger filed inside the fourteen-day window disclosed it. The IE was first disclosed in the Post-General (Q4) report filed **January 15, 2025 — 82 days late**.

25. The failure to file a supplemental report by October 25, 2024 disclosing the October 24 IE is a violation of A.R.S. § 16-958(B)(3).

Violation 2 — Failure to File Daily Trigger for the October 28, 2024 IEs (\$59,000)

26. HVF made twelve separately-itemized independent expenditures to Awareness Analytics on Monday, October 28, 2024, totaling **\$59,000**, each one opposing a Democratic legislative candidate by name (Exhibit C, Schedule E2a entries 2a-2l in Paragraph 7 above).

27. The cumulative previously-unreported expenditures on October 28 (in addition to the unreported \$1,000.27 from October 24) reached **\$60,000.27**, well above the \$1,000 supplemental threshold of A.R.S. § 16-958(A) — exceeding it by approximately sixty-fold on this single date.

28. Under A.R.S. § 16-958(B)(3), the supplemental report disclosing these twelve expenditures was due **within one business day** — i.e., **Tuesday, October 29, 2024**.

29. HVF filed a CCEC General Daily Trigger on October 29, 2024 — but the report covered "October 26, 2024 to October 26, 2024" (a Saturday on which HVF had no IE activity) and contained zero Schedule E2a entries. The October 28 IEs were not disclosed (Exhibit D).

30. No subsequent daily trigger filed inside the fourteen-day window disclosed the October 28 IEs. The IEs were first disclosed in the Post-General (Q4) report filed **January 15, 2025 — 78 days late.**

31. The failure to file a supplemental report by October 29, 2024 disclosing the twelve October 28 Awareness Analytics IEs is a violation of A.R.S. § 16-958(B)(3). Given the magnitude of the disbursement (\$59,000), the systematic pattern of opposition spending against twelve named Democratic candidates in a single day, and the existence of a contemporaneous empty filing on the very same deadline date (October 29, 2024) covering an unrelated, IE-free reporting day, this violation is the most material of the three.

Violation 3 — Failure to File Daily Trigger for the October 31, 2024 IE (\$726.18)

32. HVF made an independent expenditure of \$726.18 to Camelback Strategy Group on Thursday, October 31, 2024, opposing Committee 101641 Gonzales For AZ (Communications - Signs) (Exhibit C, Schedule E2a entry).

33. The October 31 expenditure, standing alone, was below the \$1,000 supplemental threshold. But by October 31, HVF's cumulative previously-unreported IEs in the fourteen-day window stood at **\$60,726.45** — including the \$1,000.27 from October 24 and the \$59,000 from October 28, neither of which had been disclosed in any timely supplemental. The \$1,000 supplemental threshold of A.R.S. § 16-958(A) had been continuously exceeded since October 24.

34. Under A.R.S. § 16-958(B)(3), the supplemental report covering all previously-unreported IEs was due — at the latest — **within one business day** of October 31, i.e., **Friday, November 1, 2024.**

35. HVF filed a CCEC General Daily Trigger on November 1, 2024 — but the report covered "October 29, 2024 to October 29, 2024" (a Tuesday on which HVF had no IE activity) and contained zero Schedule E2a entries. None of the October 24, October 28, or October 31 IEs were disclosed (Exhibit E).

36. No subsequent daily trigger filed inside the fourteen-day window disclosed any of the IEs. The IEs were first disclosed in the Post-General (Q4) report filed **January 15, 2025 — 75 days after the November 1 deadline for the October 31 supplemental.**

37. The failure to file a supplemental report by November 1, 2024 disclosing all previously-unreported IEs (including, in the alternative, the October 31 Camelback Strategy Group IE) is a violation of A.R.S. § 16-958(B)(3).

IV. Penalty Considerations

38. The civil penalty for an independent-expenditure reporting violation is determined under A.R.S. § 16-957 and the Commission's enforcement rules, with severity tied to the duration of the violation, the magnitude of the undisclosed activity, and the existence of any pattern of similar conduct.

39. For these three violations, three factors should be weighed at the maximum end of any applicable range:

a. Magnitude: The total undisclosed amount during the fourteen-day window is **\$60,726.45**, including a single-day Awareness Analytics buy of **\$59,000** that was 78 days late.

b. Duration: The shortest of the three violations remained undisclosed for **75 days**; the longest, **82 days**. Each fell entirely outside the fourteen-day pre-election window the statute is designed to protect.

c. Empty-trigger pattern: HVF filed two contemporaneous empty CCEC General Daily Triggers covering single days on which no IE activity occurred (10/26, 10/29), while skipping the three days on which IE activity did occur (10/24, 10/28, 10/31). The structure of those filings — selecting reporting days with no activity and skipping reporting days with substantial activity — supports a finding of willful non-compliance rather than inadvertent administrative error.

40. To the extent the Commission imposes per-day penalties, the cumulative late-day count across the three violations is **235 days** (82 + 78 + 75 days).

V. Statutory Timeline and Demands

I am providing the Commission with the following timeline expectations based on the Commission's own rules:

I request written confirmation of receipt and assignment of a complaint number pursuant to R2-20-809(F) no later than May 14, 2026.

A.R.S. § 16-957(A) requires the Commission, on a finding of reason to believe a violation has occurred, to "serve on the person an order stating with reasonable particularity the nature of the violation and requiring compliance within fourteen days." Section 16-957(B) provides that where the alleged violator does not bring the matter into compliance within those fourteen days, "the commission shall make a public finding to that effect" and "issue an order assessing a civil penalty in accordance with section 16-942."

VI. Note on Dismissal Authority

A.A.C. R2-20-206(A)(3) permits the Executive Director to close a complaint at the staff level upon "the respondent complying with the statute or rule on which the complaint is founded." By the rule's own terms, staff closure is conditioned on respondent compliance — not on a discretionary determination that the complaint is not worth pursuing.

That conditional cannot be satisfied here. The statute on which this complaint is founded — A.R.S. § 16-958(B)(3) — required HVF to file each supplemental report "within one business day" of an October 24, 2024, October 28, 2024, or October 31, 2024 IE. Those one-business-day deadlines are gone. There is no compliance available now: HVF cannot retroactively meet a deadline that ran in October 2024, and the Q4 Post-General disclosure on January 15, 2025 does not cure a § 16-958(B)(3) timing violation. Because the predicate compliance act under R2-20-206(A)(3) is impossible to perform, the staff-closure path R2-20-206(A)(3) authorizes is not available on these facts.

This complaint rests entirely on documentary evidence pulled from the Commission's own public-record system: HVF's own Schedule E2a in HVF's own Post-General (Q4) Report shows the three IE dates; HVF's own two daily-trigger filings inside the fourteen-day window are blank on their face; HVF's own filing metadata at SeeTheMoney shows no third or fourth daily trigger covering those three IE dates exists. There is no factual question to investigate. The Commission can verify every paragraph of this complaint by clicking through to the corresponding seethemoney.az.gov record.

Given (a) the magnitude of the undisclosed activity (\$60,726.45, with a single \$59,000 day the most material), (b) the duration of the violations (75 to 82 days), and (c) the empty-trigger-on-no-activity / no-trigger-on-actual-activity pattern that supports a willfulness finding, this complaint is appropriate for **referral to the full Commission** rather than staff-level closure.

VII. Requested Action

I respectfully request that the Commission:

1. Investigate HVF's failure to file timely supplemental independent-expenditure reports under A.R.S. § 16-958(B)(3) for the October 24, October 28, and October 31, 2024 IEs;

2. Determine that the two empty CCEC General Daily Trigger filings of October 29, 2024 (Report 297920) and November 1, 2024 (Report 298230) — covering reporting days on which no IE activity occurred — do not satisfy the disclosure obligation of A.R.S. § 16-958(B)(3) for the October 24, October 28, or October 31, 2024 IEs;

3. Determine that the late aggregation of all three IEs into the Post-General (Q4) report filed January 15, 2025 does not cure the cadence violations on the face of A.R.S. § 16-958(B)(3);

4. Issue an order under A.R.S. § 16-957(A) requiring HVF to comply with A.R.S. § 16-958 and stating the nature of the three violations;

5. Assess civil penalties under A.R.S. § 16-957(B) and § 16-942 calibrated to the magnitude of the undisclosed activity (\$60,726.45), the duration of the violations (75 to 82 days), and the empty-trigger pattern documented in Section II.F;

6. Refer this complaint to the full Commission for a vote — do not dismiss at the staff level under R2-20-206(A)(3) for the reasons set forth in Section VI;

7. Provide written confirmation of receipt and a complaint number pursuant to R2-20-809(F).
