***SOS-CF-2026-010 – Campaign Finance Complaint***

Dear Mr. Logvin:

The Secretary of State's Office received your complaint dated April 6, 2026, alleging, in summary, Turning Point PAC made expenditures related to the April 7, 2026 SRP Board Election without properly reporting them on campaign finance reports. The Complaint implicates A.R.S. §§ 16-926, 16-927 which concern the contents and reporting periods for campaign finance reports.

The Arizona Secretary of State is authorized to initiate investigations into alleged violations of Title 16, Chapter 6, Articles 1 to 1.7 of the Arizona Revised Statutes. Due to the SRP Board Election being out of our jurisdiction, our Office does not have authority over this complaint and must dismiss it.
