SOS-CF-2026-015 – Campaign Finance Complaint

Dear Mr. Logvin:

The Secretary of State's Office received your complaint dated May 14, 2026, alleging, in summary, the Fortify AZ committee (ID: 102154) classified expenditures that were made to vendors for the purpose of supporting a statewide initiative petition under Schedule E1 (Operating Expenses) instead of Schedule E2 (Independent and Ballot Measure Expenditures). The allegations implicate A.R.S. § 16-926, which concerns the contents of a campaign finance report.

Pursuant to A.R.S. § 16-938, the Secretary of State's Office will conduct an initial review, provide the subject of said complaint ("Respondent") reasonable opportunity to respond, and determine whether there is reasonable cause to believe that Arizona law was violated. Based upon that, the matter may be referred to the Arizona Attorney General's Office for possible enforcement action.
