Re: *SOS-CF-2026-015 – Campaign Finance Complaint*

Dear Mr. Logvin:

The Secretary of State's office received your Complaint dated May 14, 2026, alleging, in summary, the Fortify AZ committee (ID: 102154) classified expenditures that were made to vendors for the purpose of supporting a statewide initiative petition under Schedule E1 (Operating Expenses) instead of Schedule E2 (Independent and Ballot Measure Expenditures). The allegations implicate A.R.S. § 16-926, which concerns the contents of a campaign finance report.

The Arizona Secretary of State is authorized to initiate investigations into alleged violations of Title 16, Chapter 6, Articles 1 to 1.7 of the Arizona Revised Statutes. Reporting expenditures related to circulating petitions for a proposed initiative as an operating expense is not a violation of campaign finance law. Additionally, the proposed initiative for which each sponsoring committee is circulating was posted on the Secretary of State's website during circulation, so no information was withheld from the public.
