SOS-CF-2026-019 – Campaign Finance Complaint

Dear Mr. Logvin:

The Secretary of State's Office received your complaint dated June 13, 2026, alleging, in summary, that NicoPAC (ID #101721) failed to include "paid for by" disclosures on advertising signs for candidate Elijah Norton and printed disclosures for candidates Warren Petersen and Jeff Weninger that fail to meet the minimum statutory size requirement. The allegations implicate A.R.S. § 16-925, regarding advertising requirements for campaigns.

Pursuant to A.R.S. § 16-938, the Secretary of State's Office will conduct an initial review, provide the subject of said complaint ("Respondent") reasonable opportunity to respond, and determine whether there is reasonable cause to believe that Arizona law was violated. Based upon which the matter may be referred to the Arizona Attorney General's Office for possible enforcement action.
