***SOS-CF-2026-024 Campaign Finance Complaint***

Dear Mr. Logvin:

The Secretary of State's Office received your complaint dated July 5, 2026, alleging, in summary, the Better Together PAC (Committee ID #102203) failed to: disclose the political action committee making the largest aggregate contribution that exceeds \$20,000; disclose the aggregate percentage of out-of-state contributors; to make electronic disclosures readable; and to display the disclosure on the physical signs at a height of at least ten percent of the vertical height. The allegations implicate A.R.S. § 16-925, which concerns disclosure requirements.

Pursuant to A.R.S. § 16-938, the Secretary of State's Office will conduct an initial review, provide the subject of said complaint ("Respondent") reasonable opportunity to respond, and determine whether there is reasonable cause to believe that Arizona law was violated. Based upon which the matter may be referred to the Arizona Attorney General's Office for possible enforcement action.
