Mr. Logvin:

As I understand the complaint, the operative factual allegation is that around \$20,000 in expenditures reflected in campaign finance filings by this filer were not separately reflected on a VRKA filing. The complaint does not allege concealed campaign spending, undisclosed donors, or undisclosed contributions. Rather, the expenditures at issue appear to have been publicly disclosed through the Secretary of State campaign finance reporting system, and the upshot of the claim concerns whether certain expenditures were also disclosed in the manner or format the complaint contends VRKA required.

In view of the allegations presented, the complaint does not allege a sufficiently substantial violation of the VRKA to implicate the purposes of VRKA. The complaint also fails to plausibly allege civil penalties exceeding \$50,000. A.R.S. 16-977, nor would a reasonable enforcing agency pursue such liability.

Under these circumstances, requiring a formal response and investigation would impose disproportionate burdens and expense relative to the nature and scope of the alleged violation. Accordingly, I do not find that the complaint warrants further enforcement proceedings or the issuance of a request for response, and no further action will be taken on the complaint.
